General Business:

 - b. Concerns regarding drug problems, vandalism and two muggings on the St. Thomas University Campus were discussed. Security has been increased at both St. Thomas University and Annunciation Greek Orthodox School.
 - c. Concern was expressed about new construction taking place at 1425 Kippling. It is believed that a day care center is being constructed. Construction activities should be limited to 7a.m. to 7p.m.
 - d. With the 2007 slate of officers complete, a vote was held and the following individuals were elected to office:
